Examples:

- ➤ Developed and implemented a new preventative maintenance program that increased equipment readiness from 84% in 2005 to over 98% in 2007.
- ➤ Through morale building and personnel services support increased re-enlistment levels of eligible personnel from 78% in 2005 to 95% by 2008.
- Reduced pay action error rates from a record high of 22% in 2004 to less than 1% in 2006.
- Created the Coast Guard Affirmative Claims Program and collected over \$1million in previously uncollectible claims for damage to Government property.
